### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Supporters,

We hope this message finds you well! As we reflect on the summer months, our hearts are overflowing with gratitude for your unwavering support and dedication. This season has been one of the busiest in many years, with a record number of calls for help from our community.

Thanks to your generosity and commitment our small organization has been able to accomplish so much. Below is a list of what has kept us very busy between September 2023 and September 2024:

- **43 cats and kittens adopted** into loving forever homes.
- **49 cats and kittens rescued** and transitioned to partner rescues for continued care.
- **66 cats spayed/neutered/TNR'd**, helping to break the cycle of overpopulation.
- **16 serious medical cases** taken in and critical care provided to those most in need.
- **37 cats and kittens currently in our care** receiving the love and support they need to thrive and eventually find their way into adoptive homes.
- **10 unadoptable cats** and **2 senior feral cats** finding a permanent sanctuary with our dedicated board members.
- **2 new senior cats** who both require senior blood panels and dentistry. **(photos pg.4)**

Throughout the summer, we've been rescuing feral kittens, assisting senior cats with nowhere to go, and responding to urgent calls for help. Just last week we welcomed **10 tiny kittens** into our care, with commitments to welcome more in the coming weeks. The demand for our services is really high but your generosity has allowed us to rise to the challenge and change lives. At this time we are extremely low on funds. If you are able to donate we would be so grateful. If you are able to participate in any of the fundraising options on page 2 that would be wonderful.

One of our proud initiatives is our "Oops" Program, which offers free spays to individuals who surrender their kittens to us. This summer alone, this program has prevented countless litters and ensured that surrendered kittens are cared for, loved and adopted into wonderful homes. Together we're addressing overpopulation and giving cats the futures they deserve. **Continued on page 4.**

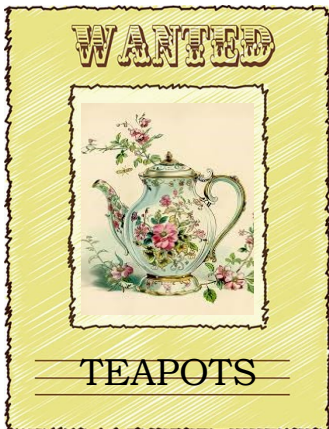

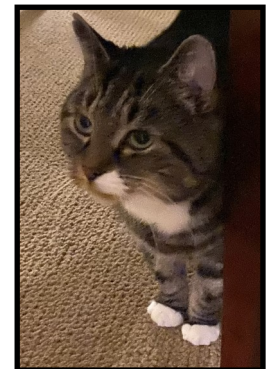
